We are pleased to be able to offer this event after many months of digital-only programming. Thank you for your interest in joining us! Here's what you need to know about the steps being taken to keep attendees and staff safe at this event:

- In accordance with the <u>"Key to NYC</u> COVID-19 requirements, upon arrival to the event, TWA hotel staff will require that all attendees show proof that they have taken at least one dose of the authorized Covid-19 vaccination along with a Government ID, to gain entry. If attendees cannot show proof of vaccination they will be denied entrance to the event.
- Ticket purchasers must provide Preservation Long Island with the names of guests attending the event by **November 3, 2021**, if not already provided during online registration.
- These are the approved methods to gain admission to an event at TWA Hotel:
 - \circ $\;$ Showing a photo or hard copy of your CDC Vaccination Record Card $\;$
 - Showing your NYC COVID Safe App
 - Showing your New York State Excelsior Pass
 - Showing an official Vaccination Record
 - Showing a photo or hard copy of an official vaccination record of a vaccine administered outside the United States for one of the following vaccines: AstraZeneca/SK Bioscience, Serum Institute of India/COVISHIELD and Vaxzevria, Sinopharm, or Sinovac.
- Masks must be worn when not actively eating or drinking. Because this is a social event with food and drinks served continuously there is no masking requirement. However, we ask you to consider donning your mask when not actively eating or drinking, particularly when interacting directly with others who may be wearing masks themselves.
- Face coverings are required for TWA Hotel staff members, guests, visitors and vendors in public areas of the hotel and when physical distancing cannot be maintained. TWA staff may ask you to remove your mask briefly to provide age or identity verification. (For security purposes, coverings that obscure the entire face are not permitted.)

In addition, based on guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the World Health Organization (WHO), the TWA Hotel is taking extraordinary preventative measures to help keep guests and team members healthy and safe through their *Above & Beyond* plan that is updated regularly to reflect the latest science.
